Membership Dues

The Men's Club dues will be \$100 for membership and handicap or \$70 for members that already have an IGA handicap. New members will be offered memberships and handicap at a reduced rate of \$60 (Just \$30 for membership plus \$30 for handicap).

Raffle Tickets

Raffle ticket sales and your dues represent the funds used throughout the season. You are encouraged to sell/purchase at least 20 tickets, any additional sales would be great as it is the only fundraiser for the Men's Club each season. Stop by the pro shop to pick up your tickets. All tickets must be turned in by the evening of May 13th – the night of the Smoker.

When turning in tickets and money to pro shop, please turn all tickets and money in at the same time.

Gold Tees/Red Tees

In order to play the gold tees, your age + handicap must equal at least 75. To play the red tees, your age + handicap must equal at least 90. You will be able to change from gold/red to white during the year, but you will not be allowed to go from white to gold/red. The tee you stipulate for tournament rounds must be the tee you have played the majority of your posted rounds.

Scores from events where you play your own ball will be posted by the handicap chairman.
